Application

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 16 January 2024 was received and considered. The Licensing Inspector does not oppose the application.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered on the papers.

In considering whether to renew the manager's certificate, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 227 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 227 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the renewal of a manager's certificate to **STEPHANIE ANNE ELIZABETH SCIASCIA** for a further period of three years and determines that the certificate will expire on the 3 February 2027.
