

DECISION 21/3531

IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

AND

IN THE MATTER of an application by **SARAH JANE WALTON** for the renewal of an off-licence, endorsed under section 40 – Remote seller of alcohol

DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

SARAH JANE WALTON has applied for the renewal of an off-licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Mahi Grove, Feilding and known as Barclae Ridge Gift Solutions. This licence was originally issued with a Section 40 endorsement (remote seller of alcohol).

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police have advised they do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 18 October 2021 was received and considered. The Inspector did not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health has advised he does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered on the papers.

In considering whether to renew the off-licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 131 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the renewal of an off-licence to **SARAH JANE WALTON** in respect of premises situated at 1 Mahi Grove, Feilding, and known as Barclae Ridge Gift Solutions, for a*



period of three years expiring on the 8th day of September 2024, subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday – 7.00 a.m. to 11.00 p.m.
3. Alcohol must only be sold or supplied within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.
4. No direct “walk in/walkout” sales may be made from the premises.

The Committee directs that the off-licence shall be endorsed to indicate that Section 40 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (Off-licences for remote sellers of alcohol) applies to the off-licence.
