

DECISION 21/3591
IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012
AND
IN THE MATTER of an application by **BROOKFIELD PARTNERSHIP LIMITED** for the issue of an off-licence

DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Chairperson of the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

BROOKFIELD PARTNERSHIP LIMITED has applied for the issue of an off-licence in respect of premises situated at 15 Stanway Road, Halcombe and known as Halcombe Tavern.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 27 April 2022 was received and considered. The Inspector did not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the Chairperson of the District Licensing Committee sitting alone.

In considering whether to issue an off-licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 105 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 105 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the issue of an off-licence to **BROOKFIELD PARTNERSHIP LIMITED** in respect of premises situated at 15 Stanway Road, Halcombe, and known as Halcombe Tavern, for a period of one year, subject to the following conditions:*

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday –10.00 a.m. to 11.00 p.m.
3. Each of the following parts of the premises is designated as:
Supervised Area Every bar
4. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
5. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample.
6. A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Willoughby Street is designated as the principal entrance.
