DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

HIMATANGI BEACH COSMOPOLITAN CLUB INCORPORATED has applied for the renewal of an off-licence in respect of premises situated at 3 Hunia Terrace, Himatangi Beach and known as Himatangi Beach Cosmopolitan Club.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 5 December 2023 was received and considered. The Inspector did not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered on the papers.

In considering whether to renew the off-licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 131 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the renewal of an off-licence to **HIMATANGI BEACH COSMOPOLITAN CLUB INCORPORATED** in respect of premises situated at 3 Hunia Terrace, Himatangi Beach and known as Himatangi Beach Cosmopolitan Club, for a period of three years expiring on the 12th day of November 2026 subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 11.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m.
2. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
3. Alcohol may be sold or supplied only to a person who—
 - (i) is a member of the club: or
 - (ii) is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
 - (iii) is a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members:
4. The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
5. Drinking water must be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
6. Alcohol purchased under this licence must be removed from the bar area by the purchaser immediately after purchase. Under no circumstances is it to be stored on the premises once purchased.
7. A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Hunia Terrace is designated as the principal entrance.
