

DECISION 21/3546
IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012
AND
IN THE MATTER of an application by
RUAHINE PORTS LIMITED
for the issue of a special licence

DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

RUAHINE PORTS LIMITED has applied for a special licence to provide alcohol sales. The application relates to the Cross Hills Gardens Country Fair 2021.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police have advised they do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 1 November 2021 was received and considered. The Inspector does not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health has advised he does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered on the papers.

In considering whether to issue a special licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 142 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the issue of a special licence to **RUAHINE PORTS LIMITED** in respect of the event for which the licence was sought, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Saturday, 20 November 2021 – 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
2. The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale so as to be easily read by people attending the event.

3. The persons nominated to manage the sale and supply of alcohol at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol is Brent Linn and a sign shall be prominently displayed at the point of sale, which identifies by name the person responsible under the licence.
4. Drinking water must be freely available at the exhibitor's site while it is open for business.
5. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
Signage at the counter, staff to check ID, minors and intoxicated persons will not be sold alcohol
6. Samples of no larger than 10ml to be served in disposable plastic tumblers.

Duration

This licence is in force from **9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m., Saturday, 20 November 2021.**
