



SPECIAL LICENCE

Sections 22, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, Tangimoana Boating Club Incorporated is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at Tangimoana Boating Club, 3 Domain Parade, Tangimoana and known as Tangimoana Boating Club to any person attending the following occasion or event (*or series of occasions or events*):

FISHING COMPETITION AND PRIZE GIVING

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions


This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Sunday, 3 April 2022 11.00 a.m. to 9.00 p.m.
2. The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale as to be easily read by people attending the event.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
4. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
Signage at the counter, staff to check ID, staff to monitor for minors and intoxicated persons, minors will not be served alcohol, intoxicated persons will not be served alcohol
5. Drinking water must be freely available from the bar while the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is available for sale as detailed in the application or similar.
7. Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to Heineken Lite and DB Export Citrus.
8. Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to tea, coffee, soft drinks and juice.
9. A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport and staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed

This licence is in force from **11. a.m. to 9.00 p.m., Sunday, 3 April 2022.**
