

DECISION 24/3986

IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

AND

IN THE MATTER of an application by
BRENT JOHN HARRIS
for the issue of a special licence

DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Commissioner of the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

BRENT JOHN HARRIS has applied for a special licence to provide alcohol sales. The application relates to the **Hoe Down 2024** event to be held at **Harrisville Speedway, 65B Tangimoana Road, Ohakea**.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 29 January 2024 was received and considered. The Inspector does not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 by the Chairperson of the District Licensing Committee sitting alone.

In considering whether to issue a special licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 142 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the issue of a special licence to **BRENT JOHN HARRIS** in respect of the events for which the licence was sought, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Saturday, 3 February 2024 – 11.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.
Sunday, 4 February 2024 – 11.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
2. The licensee must display this special licence at the point of sale so as to be easily read by people attending the event.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
4. The area where alcohol is to be sold and consumed is described in the plan date stamped as received by the District Licensing Committee on 8 February 2024 and no alcohol is to be taken out of this area.
5. The following area of the speedway is designated as:
Supervised Area Saloon and area defined on the site plan attached to the application.
6. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
Signage at the counter, staff to check ID, staff to monitor for minors and intoxicated persons, minors will not be served alcohol, intoxicated persons will not be served alcohol.
7. Drinking water must be freely available and this must be clear to customers, while the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
8. Food must be available for consumption on the premises as follows or similar:
Pizzas, burgers, wedges, chips, hotdogs, chicken and chips.
9. Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to Heineken Lite.
10. Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to soft drinks, non-alcoholic beer and orange juice:
11. A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport and staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.
12. The licensee is to provide sufficient staff to adequately perform tasks pursuant to the sale of alcohol including ID checks and roving patrols.
13. Maximum sales per person must be limited to two (2) "opened" drinks.
14. No BYO alcohol is permitted on the premises by any persons attending this event.

Duration

This licence is in force from 11.00 a.m., Saturday, 3 February 2024 until 4.00 p.m., Sunday, 4 February 2024 during the days and hours detailed in condition (1) above.
