DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

PALMERSTON NORTH MIDDLE DISTRICTS LIONS CLUB INCORPORATED has applied for a special licence to provide alcohol sales. The application is to operate a bar in the Food Court at the Central District Field Days.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 28 February 2024 was received and considered. The Inspector does not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered on the papers.

In considering whether to issue a special licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 142 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the issue of a special licence to **PALMERSTON NORTH MIDDLE DISTRICTS LIONS CLUB INCORPORATED** in respect of the event for which the licence was sought, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Thursday, 14 March 2024 – 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
Friday, 15 March 2024 – 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
Saturday, 16 March 2024 – 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
2. The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale so as to be easily read by people attending the event.
3. The persons nominated to manage the sale and supply of alcohol at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol are:
Murray Mills Craig Hart
A sign shall be prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies by name the person responsible under the licence.
4. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
Signage at the bar, staff to check ID, staff to monitor for minors and intoxicated persons, minors will not be served alcohol, intoxicated persons will not be served alcohol.
5. Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the premises are open for business:
Jugs & plastic cups at the bar
6. The maximum sales per person be limited to four (4) "opened" drinks and all sales are to be in plastic glasses or cans.
7. The applicant must ensure that no person leaves the food court area with alcohol purchased from this bar and that signs will be erected to inform patrons of this condition.
8. Food must be available for consumption on the premises as follows or similar:
Food Court - Food stalls
9. Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises as follows:
One type of light beer must be provided.
10. Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to soft drinks.
11. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.
12. The licensee must file with the District Licensing Committee a return relating to the turnover figures for the sale of alcohol.

Duration

This licence is in force from **10.00 a.m., Thursday 14 March 2024 until 4.00 p.m., Saturday, 16 March 2024** during the days and hours detailed in condition (1) above.
