



## SPECIAL LICENCE

*Sections 22, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012*

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, Te Kawau Rugby Football Club Incorporated is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at Te Kawau Memorial Recreation Centre, 1 Wye Street, Rongotea, to any person attending the following occasion or event (*or series of occasions or events*):

### **RONGOTEA LIONS SENIOR CITIZENS LUNCH**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

#### **Conditions**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Wednesday, 27 March 2024** **11.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.**
2. The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale so as to be easily read by people attending the event.
3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
4. Alcohol may be sold or supplied to the following types of people:  
Only to those people attending the events in 1) above.
5. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:  
**Signage at the counter, staff to check ID, staff to monitor for minors and intoxicated persons, minors will not be served alcohol, intoxicated persons will not be served alcohol.**
6. Drinking water must be freely available at the bar while the premises are open for business.
7. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when open for the sale of alcohol.
8. Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to Amstel Light, DB Citrus, Heineken Light.
9. Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to soft drinks, juice and ginger beer.
10. A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport and staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.

#### **Duration**

This licence is in force from 11.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m., Wednesday, 27 March 2024.
