

DECISION 24/4026

IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

AND

IN THE MATTER of an application by
FEILDING OLD BOYS OROUA RUGBY AND NETBALL CLUB INCORPORATED
for the issue of a special licence

DECISION OF THE MANAWATU DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE (ON THE PAPERS)

This application was considered by the Manawatu District Licensing Committee pursuant to the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Application

FEILDING OLD BOYS OROUA RUGBY AND NETBALL CLUB INCORPORATED has applied for a special licence to provide alcohol sales. The application relates to the after-match functions for up to six rugby fixtures allocated by the Manawatu Rugby Football Union to be played at the Kimbolton Domain. This allows for any games allocated to the club to be played at Kimbolton and in case the games that would have been played in Feilding were transferred to Kimbolton due to ground closures.

Inquiring Agency Reports

Police

The New Zealand Police do not oppose the application.

Licensing Inspector

A report from the Manawatu District Council Licensing Inspector dated 19 March 2024 was received and considered. The Inspector does not oppose the application.

Medical Officer of Health

The Medical Officer of Health does not oppose the application.

Local Alcohol Policy

There is no local alcohol policy in force within the Manawatu district.

Consideration of the application

As no objection to the application has been filed and no matters of opposition have been raised by the inquiring agencies, the application was considered on the papers.

In considering whether to issue a special licence, the licensing committee considered the criteria set out in section 142 of the Act.

District Licensing Committee decision

*Having regard to the information supporting the application and having regard to the criteria set out in section 142 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the Manawatu District Licensing Committee grants the issue of a special licence to **FEILDING OLD BOYS OROUA RUGBY AND NETBALL CLUB INCORPORATED** in respect of the event for which the licence was sought, subject to the following conditions:*

1. Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Saturdays from 20 April 2024 – 30 August 2024 – 1.00 p.m. to 8.00 p.m.
(up to 6 home games as scheduled by the Manawatu Rugby Football Union)
2. Alcohol must only be sold or supplied to the following types of people:
 - a member of the club; or
 - is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
 - a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members.
3. The licensee must display a copy of this special licence at the point of sale so as to be easily read by people attending the event.
4. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
5. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
Signage at the counter, staff to check ID, staff to monitor for minors and intoxicated persons, minors will not be served alcohol, intoxicated persons will not be served alcohol.
6. Drinking water must be freely available from the bar while the premises are open for business.
7. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times alcohol is available for sale or supply as follows or similar:
Hot chips, pies, hotdogs and pizzas
8. Low-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to DB Export Citrus and Heineken Light.
9. Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises including but not limited to soft drinks and orange juice.
10. A telephone must be freely available for customers to call for transport and staff must assist if required. Telephone numbers for alternative forms of transport from the premises must be displayed.

Duration

This licence is in force from **1.00 p.m., Saturday, 20 April 2024** until **8.00 p.m., Saturday, 30 August 2024** during the days and hours detailed in condition (1) above.
