Cr Bell will put a post on Facebook also.</b></p> <p><b>The surface of Pyke Road is very undulating on at least 2 - 3 kms of the road. This is now a busy through road due to a new sub division on Bainesse Road, tankers, stock trucks, general cartage trucks, and also residents from Taikorea all travel on this road daily. One tractor has collided into a farmers fence (after losing control when driving over one of the dips) doing considerable damage to the implement he had attached. This is from 103, right through to Bainesse Road.</b></p> <p><b>Also: People have noted to the Committee that there is no provision to pull over on the side of the road at the Hwy 56/Pyke Road corner.
