3		<p>Other Business</p> <p>A Horsfall & T Donaldson attended the Chairman/Secretary forum held at MDC.</p> <p>Finance: There will be funding from MDC available. AHorsfall/TDonaldson to meet with MDC to discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lookout development • Further Development of the Hall • Roading network – Jackytown Road/Karere Road • Upgrade of Septic system <p>Rongotea/Newbury intersection has been widened at the edges. Thanks to MDC it is much improved and residents now feel this is a safer part of the road.</p> <p>Karere Landing is the last remaining sidings from the Railway Line to Foxton. This is a Historical Place of interest. Cr Quarrie suggested contacting CEDA committee, to help with this project</p> <p>Concern was voiced over the safety, and old age of the Railway Bridge at the entrance to Longburn is no longer fit for purpose as it is too narrow for the large trucks that use this daily.
