- C Chrissie asked about a walkway/cycleway to Ohakea as per the Town Development Plan - we have until 1 Sept to contact Janine Hawthorn to put it on the wishlist
 SCC will need to give a presentation to the council about the need for Cycle/Walkway between Ohakea & Sanson. Some work needs to be done on this so maybe a plan for next year.
 Perhaps when the work begins on the wastewater, the turned soiled can be covered with lime stone and a pathway created.
- D The Mayor mentioned that she had been contacted by the Principal of Sanson School to find out why SCC turned down their application for funding.
 After listening to last months Minutes she understood it was because of the quote for the Hall cameras coming in higher than initially expected.
 The Chairman explained that under the New Charity Trust that we follow it is not set up to give Grants or Donations like the Old Market Charitable Trust would do.
 The Market, our main source of fundraising, has gone into recess and the funds have been allocated to other projects as SCC doesn't have governance over the Pool as it is an Incorporated Society in its own right.
- E SCHOOL PICK UP BUS STOP
 The Chairman discussed about moving Uzabus from the Junction to the back of the School / Community Hall which had been rejected by Uzabus as been too small
 Council was contacted to write a letter to Uzabus supporting this area for school pickups
 Reading Team suggest SEC to ask uzabus to trial it
