Kerbside Proposal One - Mobile Garbage Bin (Wheelie Bin) Refuse Collection Service

This new service is planned to be rolled out in the 2024 – 2025 financial year. Full cost implications will be included in Council's 10 Year Plan 2024 – 2034.

Kerbside Proposal Two - Food Waste Collection

It is currently planned that a 6L kitchen food waste caddy and a 23L kerbside food waste collection bin will be provided to customers as part of this new service.

The new food waste collection service is planned to be rolled out in the 2024 – 2025 financial year.

Kerbside Proposal Three - Comingled Recycling and Glass Collection to Rongotea, Sanson, Halcombe and Himatangi Beach

This service will include the provision of a recycling bin and a black crate for glass, as well as a bin clip to protect the environment from recycling bins tipping over in the wind.

This new service is planned to be implemented in the 2024 – 2025 financial year.

Council Report: Andrew Quarrie.

The official Sanson/Ohakea Rural Water opening is being held on Tuesday 16th August 2022 at 11am.

Feilding Library Renovations: The Feilding Library will be closed from Monday 15th August 2022 until Saturday 20th August 2022 to move the remaining items to the temporary library and library services will continue from Monday 22nd August 2022 from 10 Goodbehere Street, Feilding to allow for the Redevelopment of the Library.

Due to lack of maintenance by NZTA on Dundas Road (SH3) Sanson, several drains became blocked and flooded during the last torrential rain which has happened quite often.

Walking Track on Cemetery Road, Sanson is scoured after heavy rain and is dangerous for walkers to navigate.

General Business:

Road signs on Cemetery Road, as previously discussed it was proposed that the 50k sign be moved 30 metres back up Cemetery Road before the culvert coming towards Sanson and the rest of Cemetery Road become 80k. **Andrew Quarrie is to follow up regarding the 50k and 80k signs.**

The seat from the tarpot on Cemetery Road has been repaired and placed back and the doggie poo bin has been moved to the village side of the tarpot.

The security cameras suggested for the playground area is still being looked into.

As the Sanson Community Development Plan is up for review on Wednesday 14th September 2022. All members of the Community are welcome to come along and put forward their views on the future development of Sanson.

The Welcome to Sanson sign on SH1 (Wellington Road) is broken and Grant is waiting for the quote from the sign maker.
