Inwards Correspondence	Email from Negin about fire hydrants for Sanson Community. Negin had a chat with Vicki Wills (Emergency Management Coordinator, MDC) regarding the requests that was raised at the July meeting about adding more fire hydrants and having more firefighting capability in Sanson. MDC is happy with providing Sanson Community with more hydrants, however SCC need to add this to our long-term plan.

Matters Arising	Re: water filter for the hall, James Adamson has said as the hall is connected to the town supply there is no need to purchase an under-bench water filtration kit as this would only add additional costs as SCC would need to replace the filters.
Councillor's Report	The main focus is the Long-Term Plan. It is now time to start thinking about what projects Sanson community would like to make funding requests for in preparation for a submission. Suggestions so far have been, Fire hydrants, rubbish bins, Liming – Del Parker walkway, more footpaths on the back roads. A draft copy will be made available to SCC after Xmas.

Alicea asked what the hall charges are to hire out the hall and requested to see the charges for the hall and Alicea supplied information from the Rangitikei District Council about their hall hire rates for Sanson hall sub-committee to review and their decision was discussed. SCC Terms of Reference, it was mentioned that the operating budget of \$200 for the hall and market be added into the terms of reference. The Ohakea roundabout, the next stage for this is waiting for dry weather some dry weather before commencement can begin. Stephen Gill has recruited a new member from Sanson for the Emergency Management Plan. Stephen Gill mentioned about advertising on Facebook for SCC and the Sanson Community Market and to see if the market could be advertised weekly to let people know what stalls will be there every Sunday, Chris to talk to the stallholders and will report back at the next meeting.
