Council Reports: Andrew Quarrie

- A. 3 Waters, The council having weighed up all the information available, is determined to resist the government's attempts to introduce its proposed new 3waters model and is working closely with the many other councils that also are resistant to change.
- B. Feilding Library up grade, there has been a dramatic increase in the forecast cost to \$8.9mil
- C. Final proposal for representation on council, ie the number of councillors, per ward. Council has voted to reduce the number of councillors, from 5 to 4 in both the rural and Feilding wards, it still includes a Maori ward for 1 councillor.
