Matters Arising	<p>Water filter payment still not paid to Alicea even though it was approved at the May meeting. Del Parker said it is not needed and should have had a say in decision about the water filter and Grant takes full responsibility got not informing Del or Jen. MDC owns the hall and Alison to find if council will purchase the water filter and will let SCC know at the July Meeting. Moved: Grant McGaughey. Seconded: Stephen Gill.</p> <p>MDC Community Action Report, Sanson Village entrance roadside garden job booked in to be done on the 20th April 2023 and last update on 12th June 2023 is now completed.</p> <p>Sanson hall exit door/draft stopper has fallen off and last update was on the 12th June 2023 as still on going.</p> <p>Google maps was given to Grant regarding the service lanes in Sanson and Chris will let know Grant where exactly the lanes are on the map before it is passed on to MDC.</p> <p>A discussion was made last month about the steel rubbish bins near the playground on Dundas and it will be to expensive to purchase more for around Sanson.</p>
Councillor's Report	<p>Sanson Wastewater network vapour testing underway (helps locate any maintenance issues)</p> <p>Two sites along SH1/3 fenced off for new Wastewater Centralisation pump stations.</p> <p>Dog registrations due by July 31st 2023.</p>

	<p>Plastic recycling. From 1st July single use and hard to recycle plastics will be phased out eg. plastic plates, straws, cutlery.</p> <p>Feilding and District Business awards, Sanson businesses & employees eligible but close soon – 18th June 2023.</p> <p>MDC Community Honours nominations open until 31st July 2023. Anyone in Sanson you would like to nominate?</p> <p>Bioplant Manawatu have withdrawn their Resource Consent from Horizons for their Pyrolysis Plant and will not be proceeding further at this stage.</p> <p>Feilding Library / Community Hub building construction tracking well. Turners Rd (off Kawakawa Rd) road extension and turn bay construction in industrial area tracking well.</p>
General Business	<p>The Scarlet red tree has been delivered and we need to organise a day when everyone is free to attend to plant the tree and would like to include Sanson School in this and it was decided to leave the planting till after the July school holidays. Can all SCC members please email Chris with dates when and if they are free to attend. Stephen Gill mentioned he will sponsor the purchase of plaque for in front of the tree.</p> <p>Mid-Winter Lunch at the church café will not go ahead due to Committee Members unavailable on weekdays or weekend due to work or other commitments.</p> <p>Community Garden will look at this in the near future.</p> <p>Microwave for the hall – still to decide on.</p> <p>Inventory List for the hall kitchen has been stopped and no more items to be purchased.</p> <p>ID Badges, this will be discussed at a later date.</p> <p>Sanson Snippets, costs are still needed before this will go ahead.</p> <p>Pam mentioned about information/history boards around the district and has photos which Pam will email to Chris for some ideas for our information/history boards for Sanson.</p> <p>Chris mentioned that there is a shortage of coffee cups in the hall cupboard and need to purchase 100 coffee cups and need approval from SCC members. This was approved with 5 members agreeing to the purchase.</p> <p>Hangars Project at Ohakea: extension is now due November 2024 due to errors.</p> <p>Del Parker mentioned that she needed to have a voice and asked Grant to be co-opted back onto the Sanson Community Committee. Moved: Grant McGaughey. Seconded: Steve Smith. Passed and accepted by all Committee members present at the meeting. Welcome back Del.</p> <p>The heat pump has been working well and Del has been giving people who booked the hall instructions on how to use it and the set up for the app is not required at this stage but can be set up if any problems arise.</p> <p>Alicea mentioned about the firewood, this has been put on hold for now, until there is access to the wood splitter again.</p>

	Grant mentioned he has a supply of pinecones at his place which he has kindly donated to SCC. Thanks Grant.
