Matters arising:

- Grant application to Central Energy Trust for new heaters and fridge submitted. Thank you to Hilary & Jennifer. Hopefully we will know outcome by next meeting.
- Thanks to Feilding Flooring Xtra and Kimbolton School for the large piece of 2nd hand carpet which has been laid loosely on the hall stage.
- We have purchased an infra-red heater on stand for the hall being paid for by community committee funds.

Correspondence: Russ has informed us that there will be another firewood working bee this weekend with community members and Rongotea Lions. Please list the households that haven't had any yet. This is the wood from the Camp Ground trees.

Hall update:

- Ken can start list of R&M jobs in June starting with building a storage cupboard.
- Jennifer borrowing a water blaster for cleaning outside walls of hall.
- Carpet. Need to finalise cutting to size by next hall hire late May. Ian suggested contacting Bob Padget for advice.
- Hilary asked if we could work on updating the hall hire policy next meeting including hall hire pricing, bond, terms of hire etc.
- Paula is organising a monthly garage sale. Stallholders fee is a fundraiser for hall. Hall has sold some items no longer required – plastic chairs, trestle tables, candelabra.

MDC Update:

- The new Mangaweka Bridge is opening this Friday.
- Waste Management & Minimisation Plan. Received 93 submissions and will hear those who wish to come and talk to us this Thursday.
- Speed reductions adopted. Halcombe – Mt Stewart Rd & Cemetery Rd will now be 80km. The back streets of Halcombe and Sanson will be 40km. School speed zones of 40km outside 3 Feilding schools.

- Many infrastructure projects underway. Ohakea Rural Water Scheme nearing completion, wastewater centralisation Sanson to Feilding section complete, Ohakea section underway, Rongotea next. Footpaths and stormwater upgrades in Rongotea, cycle lanes in North St Feilding, new bore (third one) for Feilding starting soon.
- Council recently held its annual community committee forum. Thank you to Hilary for representing Tangimoana.

General business:

1. Boat Club going well. New bar manager.
2. Ian raised ideas for fundraising including a kids disco, games night, talent quest, community midwinter potluck dinner. It was agreed to work on the community dinner first.
3. Samba deer crossing Tangimoana Rd. This is quite a hazard. There is one caution sign near village. Could we request another one in area near cell phone tower closer to Rosina Rd.?
4. Speed hump at main entrance to village. This is deteriorating. Could MDC Roding please check. Pot-holes forming and rubber judder bar coming loose in places.
5. Trees on Rosina Rd. A second roadside tree had come down and needed clearing. These trees are growing in the road berm. Could MDC Roding please check these older trees for condition as others might start coming down too.
6. Street-lights. There are a number of street-lights out in the village. One outside the dairy, several in Kuku St and there are probably others. Could MDC Roding please check.
7. Community information board. Sam has some H5 posts he is offering so the sign can be moved back to catch the street lighting better.
