Hall update: Quotes for heaters and hall maintenance discussed, Feilding Flooring Xtra think they can source a large 2nd hand carpet as they are recarpeting some classrooms at a school shortly and will see if some of the old carpet being uplifted is suitable. A big thank you to (?) who has kindly donated a vacuum cleaner. History boards discussed.

The plan:

- Purchase one heater on stand for immediate use.
- Formalise financials so we can apply to Central Energy Trust (closes 1st May)
- Grant application for a further four heaters and a new fridge for kitchen.
- Use the Community Committee funds to purchase the first heater asap and also for the cost of installation of the other four heaters.
- By reprioritizing the existing list of projects, we can move forward the list of \$3000 hall maintenance items.
- There is enough tagged funding within the MDC grant for the centennial to start the history board project.

Community Committee Project Fund: - Reprioritised list

1. Purchase one infrared heater on stand immediately (\$424.00)
2. If we are unsuccessful with a CET grant, four further heaters and a fridge (up to \$2000)
3. Installation of four heaters being wall mounted (quote required)
4. Hall maintenance projects as listed (up to \$3000)
5. History boards, continue next stage of project if funds allow
6. ANZAC sculpture not happening this financial year
